











Jaundice

Causes:

-  Liver diseases (hepatitis, cirrhosis)
-  Blocked bile ducts (gallstones, tumors)
-  Hemolytic anemia (excessive breakdown of red blood cells)
-  Genetic disorders (Gilbert's syndrome)
-  Certain medications

Symptoms:

-  Yellowing of skin and eyes
-  Dark urine
-  Pale or clay-colored stools
-  Itching (pruritus)
-  Fatigue
