Liver diseases (hepatitis, cirrhosis)



Blocked bile ducts (gallstones, tumors)



Hemolytic anemia (excessive breakdown of red blood cells)



Genetic disorders (Gilbert's syndrome)



Certain medications

Yellowing of skin and eyes



Dark urine



Pale or clay-colored stools



**Itching** (pruritus)



**Fatigue**
